Chairman's Report for the 2018 AGM

The Committee met seven times during 2017 with each meeting lasting about 2 hours. In addition to this time many of the committee members spent significant further time working on club business and helping to organise and run events through the year.

The Club again had a busy year with several well organised events and thanks to Geoff Caton a busy programme of Saturday morning rides.

Junior racing in the park took place on 3 days with support from many juniors including riders from the Irish Republic and the Isle of Man. The races raise the profile of the club and generate significant revenue. More on this below

The President organised a successful day of racing, with an oversubscribed men's race and a well-supported ladies race, again generating revenue for the club and raising the profile.

The Club series of Time Trials again proved popular with members and other clubs and the open 25 was well supported. Thanks to Alan Stark for his hard work through the year.

Kit sales continued at a high level so thanks to Howard Massam for all his patience. Our Press Secretary, Claire MacKinnon worked hard to get articles included in the local papers and Aaron Green again organised a much appreciated Annual Dinner and Prize Presentation. Thanks to all the other committee members for their input and hard work.

The Future

Time Trials, Road Races, Youth Races and Club rides will again form the main part of the programme for the year.

The Dolan Series of races will take place on three Saturdays – 23rd and 30th March and 6th April in 2019. It was not possible to agree a date with the park management for any other days of racing in 2019. Club 10s will this year take place on a new course.

The Committee have been reviewing and revising the Racing Rules and trophy lists to bring them up to date and make the balance between the genders more even. Any suggestions to make the club more inclusive would be welcome.

We are examining the possibility of a secure store adjacent to the Club Room.

The committee considered the club's "Go-Ride" status and concluded that we were not able to apply for this accreditation. This has implications for any youth members wishing to attend BC training courses.

To all the members who have worked hard to contribute to the running of the club and it's events a big thank you – without you it would not happen.

Finally, it is your club. If you think we should do something different/ better/ faster/ longer etc. then talk to someone on the committee and tell them your idea. You could even get involved and be on the Committee and make it happen!
